


1. Salaries




Insights
Salaries vary widely by region and school type. Most international and private schools offer the **highest pay**. Rural jobs trade **lower pay** for slower pace and lower cost of living.

2. Locations




Insights
Nearly **1 in 3** TEFL jobs are in Bangkok. **Rural listings are rare (2%)**, but may appeal to teachers seeking a quieter lifestyle.

3. School Types Hiring



Insights
Private schools dominate the job market. International and public schools often **require higher qualifications**. **Language centres offer flexible or entry-level options**.

4. Student Age Groups



Insights
Early education dominates hiring. University/adult teaching roles are **niche and competitive**. "Other" reflects vague or agency-based listings.

5. Job Benefit Highlights



Insights
Benefits are modest but common in international/private schools. **Visa and leave support are standard**; housing and flights are less so.


6. Contracts



Insights
Most **contracts are renewable** year-to-year. Many schools expect **commitment** through full academic years.

Most schools require **at least a degree and TEFL certification**. **Experience boosts hiring chances** but isn't always essential. **Non-native teachers with strong English skills** are increasingly welcome.
